Constituted 29 July 1944 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 501st Quartermaster Battalion, and activated in England

Allotted 6 December 1950 to the Regular Army

Inactivated 21 February 1955 in Korea

Redesignated 7 April 1966 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 501st Field Depot

Activated 1 June 1966 at Granite City Army Depot, Illinois

Inactivated 20 December 1968 in Thailand

Redesignated 16 April 1986 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 501st Support Group, and activated in Korea

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 2006 as the 501st Sustainment Brigade


