Ordered into active Federal service 5 December 2003 at home stations; released from active Federal service 1 June 2005 and reverted to state control

Redesignated 1 October 2005 as the 2d Battalion, 114th Aviation Regiment

Converted and redesignated 1 September 2006 as the 777th Support Battalion

Reorganized 1 September 2007 in the Arkansas and Hawaii Army National Guard with Headquarters at North Little Rock; on 5 August 2008 in the Arkansas, Hawaii, and Oklahoma Army National Guard

Ordered active Federal service 9 June 2016 at home stations; released from active Federal service 13 July 2017 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 31 August 2019 in the Arkansas, Hawaii, Oklahoma, Puerto Rico, Tennessee, Virginia, and Wyoming Army National Guard with Headquarters at North Little Rock
