Redesignated 1 July 1940 as the 88th Engineer Battalion

Activated 2 June 1941 at Camp Beauregard, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 1 August 1942 as the 88th Engineer Heavy Ponton Battalion

Inactivated 23 November 1945 at Camp Bowie, Texas

Redesignated 9 December 1954 as the 88th Engineer Battalion

Activated 9 February 1955 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Inactivated 15 May 1956 at Fort Carson, Colorado

(Headquarters, Headquarters and Service Company redesignated 5 December 1956 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment)

Battalion activated 24 December 1956 in France

(Companies A, B, and C disbanded 27 September 1960)

Inactivated 24 September 1962 in France

Activated 25 June 1965 at Granite City Army Depot, Illinois

Converted and redesignated 20 July 1966 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 88th Supply and Service Battalion

Inactivated 11 May 1972 at Travis Air Force Base, California
