HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 1103d SUPPORT BATTALION

Organized and Federally recognized 10 March 1951 in the Alabama Army National Guard at Eufaula as Battery D, 278th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion

Battery D, 104th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion (NGUS), organized and Federally recognized 16 March 1953 at Eufaula

Battery D, 278th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion, and Battery D, 104th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion (NGUS), consolidated 23 March 1953 and consolidated unit designated as Battery D, 104th Antiaircraft Artillery Automatic Weapons Battalion (NGUS)

Redesignated 1 October 1953 as Battery D, 104th Antiaircraft Artillery Battalion (NGUS)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 June 1954 as Battery D, 104th Antiaircraft Artillery Battalion

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 2 May 1959 as Company E, 2d Battle Group, 167th Infantry, an element of the 31st Infantry Division

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 15 April 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 103d Military Police Battalion, and relieved from assignment to the 31st Infantry Division

Ordered into active Federal service 11 June 1963 at Eufaula; released from active Federal service 17 June 1963 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 10 September 1963 at Eufaula; released from active Federal service 12 September 1963 and reverted to state control

HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 1103d SUPPORT BATTALION

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 December 1969 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 1103d Transportation Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 11 December 1990 at Eufaula; released from active Federal service 26 November 1991 and reverted to state control

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 September 1994 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 1103d Support Battalion

Ordered into active Federal service 5 May 2007 at Eufaula; released from active Federal service 7 June 2008 and reverted to state control


