

Lineage and Honors

330th REGIMENT

Constituted 5 August 1917 in the National Army as the 330th Infantry and assigned to the 83d Division

Organized 30 August 1917 at Camp Sherman, Ohio

Demobilized 13 February - 10 April 1919 at Camp Sherman, Ohio

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 330th Infantry and assigned to the 83d Division (later redesignated as the 83d Infantry Division)

Organized in November 1921 with Headquarters at Alliance, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 15 August 1942 and reorganized at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Inactivated 27 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Activated 1 October 1946 with Headquarters at Fort Wayne, Indiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Relieved 1 March 1952 from assignment to the 83d Infantry Division and assigned to the 70th Infantry Division

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1959 as the 330th Regiment, an element of the 70th Division (Training), with Headquarters at Detroit, Michigan

330th REGIMENT

(Location of Headquarters changed 7 April 1966 to Fraser, Michigan)

Reorganized 31 January 1968 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 70th Division (Training)

Reorganized 1 October 1994 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 70th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 13 January 1995 to consist of the 1st and 2d Battalions, elements of the 70th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 16 October - 16 November 1996 to consist of the 1st and 2d Battalions, elements of the 84th Division (Institutional Training)

Elements ordered into active military service in support of the War on Terrorism

Reorganized 1 October 2004 to consist of the 1st and 2d Battalions, elements of the 100th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 17 October 2005 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 100th Division (Institutional Training)

(1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions relieved 1 October 2007 from assignment to the 100th Division [Institutional Training] and assigned to the 98th Training Division)

(1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions relieved 1 October 2008 from assignment to the 98th Training Division and assigned to the 95th Training Division)
