

Lineage and Honors

389th REGIMENT

Constituted 23 July 1918 in the National Army as the 389th Infantry and assigned to the 98th Division

Demobilized 30 November 1918

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 389th Infantry and assigned to the 98th Division (later redesignated as the 98th Infantry Division)

Organized in December 1921 with Headquarters at Albany, New York

Ordered into active military service 15 September 1942 and reorganized at Camp Breckinridge, Kentucky

Inactivated 16 February 1946 in Japan

Activated 19 December 1946 in the Organized Reserves with Headquarters at Albany, New York

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

(Location of Headquarters changed 13 August 1948 to Schenectady, New York)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 May 1959 as the 389th Regiment, an element of the 98th Division (Training), with Headquarters at Schenectady, New York

Reorganized 31 January 1968 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 98th Division (Training)

389th REGIMENT

Reorganized 17 November 1982 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, and 4th Battalions, elements of the 98th Division (Training)

Reorganized 1 March 1991 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 4th Battalions, elements of the 98th Division (Training)

Reorganized 1 October 1994 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 4th Battalions, elements of the 98th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 13 January 1995 to consist of the 4th Battalion, an element of the 98th Division (Training)

Reorganized 16 October 1996 to consist of the 1st and 2d Battalions, elements of the 98th Division (Institutional Training)

Elements ordered into active military service in support of the War on Terrorism

(1st and 2d Battalions relieved 1 October 2007 from assignment to the 98th Division [Institutional Training], and assigned to the 95th Division [Institutional Training])

(1st and 2d Battalions relieved 1 October 2008 from assignment to the 95th Division [Institutional Training], and assigned to the 98th Training Division)
