95th REGIMENT

Constituted 4 September 1918 in the National Army as Headquarters, 170th Field Artillery Brigade, and assigned to the 95th Division

Organized 16 September 1918 at Camp Knox, Kentucky

Demobilized 22 December 1918 at Camp Knox, Kentucky

Reconstituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 170th Field Artillery Brigade, and assigned to the 95th Division

Organized in November 1921 at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

Reorganized and redesignated 13 February 1942 as Headquarters and Headquarters Battery, 95th Division Artillery

Ordered into active military service 15 July 1942 and reorganized at Camp Swift, Texas

Inactivated 15 October 1945 at Camp Shelby, Mississippi

Activated 13 May 1947 in the Organized Reserves at Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 95th Regiment, an element of the 95th Division (Training), and location changed to Shreveport, Louisiana (organic elements concurrently organized as new units)

Regiment reorganized 30 December 1967 to consist of the 1st and 2d Battalions, elements of the 95th Division (Training)

Reorganized 1 September 1971 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 95th Division (Training)

Reorganized 1 October 1994 to consist of the 1st, 2d, and 3d Battalions, elements of the 95th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 16 October-16 November 1996 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th Battalions, elements of the 95th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 13 April 2002 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th Battalions, elements of the 95th Division (Institutional Training)

Regiment reorganized 1 October 2006 as a parent regiment under the United States Army Regimental System; concurrently 11th and 12th Battalions relived from assignment to the 95th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized 15 April 2008 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 13th Battalions; 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 13th Battalions elements of the 95th Division (Institutional Training)

(1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th Battalions relived 1 October 2008 from assignment to the 95th Division [Institutional Training])

Reorganized 15 April 2009 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th Battalions

Reorganized 15 September 2009 to consist of the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 14th Battalions
