Lineage and Honors

5th BRIGADE, 102d TRAINING DIVISION

Constituted 24 June 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 102d Division Train, Quartermaster Corps

Organized in November 1921 with Headquarters at St. Louis, Missouri

Redesignated 23 March 1925 as the 102d Division Quartermaster Train

Reorganized and redesignated 1 July 1936 as the 427th Quartermaster Regiment and remained assigned to the 102d Division (later redesignated as the 102d Infantry Division)

Redesignated 30 January 1942 as the 427th Quartermaster Battalion

Ordered into active military service 15 September 1942 and reorganized at Camp Maxey, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated (less Ordnance Maintenance Platoon, Headquarters Company) 27 September 1942 as the 102d Quartermaster Company, 102d Infantry Division (Ordnance Maintenance Platoon, Headquarters Company--hereafter separate lineage)

Redesignated 16 August 1943 as the 102d Quartermaster Company

Inactivated 23 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Activated 3 January 1947 at Danville, Illinois

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 1 February 1950 to Belleville, Illinois

5th BRIGADE, 102d TRAINING DIVISION

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 102d Supply and Transport Battalion, an element of the 102d Infantry Division; concurrently organic elements constituted and activated

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Belleville, Illinois

Redesignated 23 May 2018 as the 5th Brigade, 102d Training Division

Activated 1 October 2018 at Sacramento, California

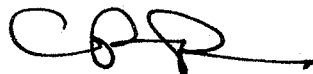
