Reorganized and redesignated 30 April 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 108th Division (Training)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1994 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 108th Division (Institutional Training)

Reorganized and redesignated 16 September 2008 as Headquarters, 108th Training Command
