Constituted 15 March 1956 in the Virginia Army National Guard as Company A, 1030th Engineer Battalion

Organized and Federally recognized 17 September 1956 at Big Stone Gap

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1968 as the 2d Platoon, 1031st Engineer Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1971 as the 1032d Engineer Company

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 November 1975 as the 1032d Transportation Company

Ordered into active Federal service 20 November 1990 at Big Stone Gap; released from active Federal service 5 June 1991 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 January 1996 with the 1033d Transportation Company (see ANNEX 1) and consolidated unit designated as the 1032d Transportation Company; concurrently, location changed to Gate City

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 2000 as Detachment 2, 1032d Transportation Company

Ordered into active Federal service 7 February 2003 at Gate City; released from active Federal service 6 June 2004 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 October 2008 with the 1032d Transportation Company (see ANNEX 2) and consolidated unit designated as the 1032d Transportation Company

## **ANNEX 1**

Constituted 31 March 1975 in the Virginia Army National Guard as the 1033d Transportation Company

Organized and Federally recognized 1 April 1975 at Gate City

Ordered into active Federal service 18 November 1990 at Gate City; released from active Federal service 19 June 1991 and reverted to state control

## **ANNEX 2**

Constituted 1 January 1989 in the Virginia Army National Guard as Detachment 1, 1032d Transportation Company

Organized and Federally recognized 2 March 1989 at Bristol

Ordered into active Federal service 20 November 1990 at Bristol; released from active Federal service 5 June 1991 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 2000 as the 1032d Transportation Company

Ordered into active Federal service 7 February 2003 at Bristol; released from active Federal service 6 June 2004 and reverted to state control
