Inactivated 26 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3358th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 1 September 1948 as the 109th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 September 1948 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma

Inactivated 25 January 1949 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma

Activated 4 June 1951 at Hammelburg, Germany

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1953 as the 109th Transportation Company

Converted and redesignated 1 September 1965 as Company C, 97th Quartermaster Battalion

Converted and redesignated 23 September 1974 as the 109th Transportation Company
