Constituted 10 November 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company G, 466th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 10 December 1942 at Fort Custer, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 11 December 1943 as the 3607th Quartermaster Truck Company

Disbanded 14 March 1945 in Italy

Reconstituted, converted and redesignated 1 March 1949 as the 126th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 8 July 1949 at Manchester, New Hampshire

Inactivated 13 September 1949 at Manchester, New Hampshire

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 21 January 1955 as the 126th Transportation Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Army Reserve and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 March 1955 at Fort Eustis, Virginia
