Activated 15 May 1946 in Italy

Redesignated 10 September 1947 as the 142d Transportation Traffic Regulation Detachment

Inactivated 15 October 1947 in Italy

Redesignated 31 March 1959 as the 142d Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 24 April 1959 at Columbus, Ohio

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Columbus, Ohio

Activated 16 May 1985 at Jamaica, New York

Ordered into active military service 27 August 1990 at Jamaica, New York; released 18 May 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status
