Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 April 1959 as the 1st Rifle Platoon, Company C, 2d Battle Group, 120th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 10 March 1963 as the 2d Rifle Platoon, Company C, 2d Battalion, 120th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1964 as the 2d and 3d Rifle Platoons, Company C, 2d Battalion, 120th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1968 as the 3d Rifle Platoon, Company A, 2d Battalion, 120th Infantry

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1970 as Detachment 1, Company A, 2d Battalion, 120th Infantry

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 December 1971 as Detachment 1, 1451st Transportation Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 August 1972 as the 1451st Transportation Company

Ordered into active Federal service 29 November 1990 at Boone; released from active Federal service 30 June 1991 and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 September 1993 with Detachment 1, 1451st Transportation Company (organized and Federally recognized 6 November 1992 at Lenoir) and consolidated unit designated as the 1451st Transportation Company
