**145th TRANSPORTATION DETACHMENT**

Constituted 26 April 1946 in the Army of the United States as the 145th Transportation Corps Traffic Regulation Detachment

Activated 15 May 1946 in Italy

Redesignated 28 June 1947 as the 145th Transportation Traffic Regulation Detachment

Inactivated 15 October 1947 in Italy

Redesignated 3 April 1959 as the 145th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 18 May 1959 at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania

Ordered into active military service 15 October 1961 at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; released from active military service 4 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 1 January 1967 to Leetsdale, Pennsylvania; on 1 May 1970 to Butler, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Butler, Pennsylvania

Activated 16 April 1984 at Hampton, Virginia

Ordered into active military service 27 August 1990 at Hampton, Virginia; released from active military service 30 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status
