Constituted 22 November 1948 in the Organized Reserve Corps as the 172d Transportation Truck Company

Activated 7 December 1948 at Omaha, Nebraska

Reorganized and redesignated 23 March 1950 as the 172d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Inactivated 24 October 1950 at Omaha, Nebraska

Activated 15 April 1952 at Omaha, Nebraska

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1953 as the 172d Transportation Company

Ordered into active military service 13 May 1968 at Omaha, Nebraska; released from active military service 7 October 1969 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 11 October 1990 at Omaha, Nebraska; released from active military service 11 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 10 January 2004 at Omaha, Nebraska; released from active military service 7 July 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Omaha, Nebraska

Activated 16 September 2021 at Fort Bliss, Texas


