Activated 7 June 1944 in Algeria

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 203d Transportation Corps Car Company

Inactivated 2 February 1947 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

Redesignated 15 February 1949 as the 203d Transportation Truck Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 10 March 1949 at New York, New York

Inactivated 15 March 1951 at New York, New York

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 14 April 1964 as the 203d Transportation Company

Activated 1 May 1964 at New York, New York

Ordered into active military service 13 May 1968 at New York, New York; released from active military service 5 December 1969 and reverted to reserve status with location at Hempstead, New York

Inactivated 12 December 1969 at Hempstead, New York
