Constituted 1 May 1936 in the Regular Army as Company E, 36th Quartermaster Regiment

Redesignated 1 June 1940 as the 204th Quartermaster Company

Redesignated 16 June 1942 as the 204th Quartermaster Car Company

Activated 7 June 1944 at Algiers, Algeria

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 204th Transportation Corps Car Company

Redesignated 28 June 1947 as the 204th Transportation Car Company

Inactivated 10 November 1947 at Leghorn, Italy

Withdrawn 17 March 1948 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 2 April 1948 at New York, New York

Inactivated 25 February 1949 at New York, New York

Activated 22 June 1949 at New York, New York

Redesignated 1 September 1953 as the 204th Transportation Company
