Constituted 11 March 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 2255th Quartermaster Truck Company, Aviation

Activated 14 March 1944 at Kelly Field, Texas

Inactivated 31 December 1945 in France

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 2255th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 29 October 1948 as the 227th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 11 November 1948 at Albemarle, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 1 February 1950 as the 227th Transportation Heavy Truck Company

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 30 April 1953 as the 227th Transportation Company

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Albemarle, North Carolina; released from active military service 11 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 6 December 1990 at Albemarle, North Carolina; released from active military service 5 July 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 28 January 2004 at Albemarle, North Carolina; released from active military service 25 July 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Albemarle, North Carolina
