Constituted 26 December 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 493d Port Battalion, Transportation Corps

Activated 25 February 1943 at Jackson Barracks, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 25 June 1943 as the 236th Port Company

Inactivated 25 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 27 December 1948 as the 236th Transportation Port Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 1 February 1949 at Des Moines, Iowa

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 14 September 1954 at Des Moines, Iowa

Redesignated 13 July 1956 as the 236th Transportation Company and activated at Port Huron, Michigan

Location changed 1 November 1963 to Marine City, Michigan; on 15 March 1977 to Selfridge, Michigan

Inactivated 16 July 1979 at Selfridge, Michigan

Activated 16 September 2008 at Bay City, Michigan
