Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3335th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 15 March 1965 as the 258th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 26 March 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 19 April 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Activated 1 July 1965 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 1 January 1967 at Cam Ranh Bay, Vietnam

Activated 25 August 1967 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Inactivated 15 June 1970 at Korat, Thailand
