Inactivated 10 October 1945 in the Philippines

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3349th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 22 April 1965 as the 261st Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 May 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 24 December 1968 in Vietnam

Activated 1 September 1981 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
