268th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 16 July 1945 in the Army of the United States as the 4608th Quartermaster Truck Company

Activated 20 August 1945 in the Philippines

Inactivated 31 May 1946 in the Philippines

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 4608th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 27 January 1948 as the 268th Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 12 February 1948 at San Juan, Puerto Rico

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1953 as the 268th Transportation Company

Location changed 1 November 1969 to Puerto Nuevo, Puerto Rico; on 17 March 1974 to Bayamon, Puerto Rico; on 16 March 1997 to Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico

Element ordered into active military service 15 May 2004 at Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 10 November 2005 and reverted to reserve status

268th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Ordered into active military service 2 January 2008 and 17 April 2008 at Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 4 February 2009 and 21 May 2009 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 20 October 2012 at Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 23 November 2013 and reverted to reserve status


