Redesignated 22 April 1965 as the 274th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 May 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 30 June 1971 at Saigon, Vietnam

Activated 16 September 1979 at Rhein-Main, Germany

Inactivated 1 May 1986 at Oberursel, Germany

Activated 16 November 1994 at Fort Stewart, Georgia
