Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3379th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 23 April 1965 as the 276th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 27 April 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 22 November 1970 at Fort Eustis, Virginia
