Constituted 16 October 1947 in the Organized Reserves as the 281st Transportation Port Company

Activated 3 November 1947 at Dallas, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 20 September 1950 at Dallas, Texas

Redesignated 2 November 1955 as the 281st Transportation Company

Activated 1 December 1955 at Dallas, Texas

Location changed 14 May 1956 to Clovis, New Mexico

Inactivated 1 June 1959 at Clovis, New Mexico

Activated 15 December 1967 at Las Cruces, New Mexico

Ordered into active military service 20 September 1990 at Las Cruces, New Mexico; released 3 June 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Detachment ordered into active military service 1 November 2002 at Las Cruces, New Mexico; remainder of company ordered into active military service 7 February 2003 at Las Cruces; New Mexico

Detachment released 31 October 2003 from active military service and reverted to reserve status; remainder of company released 6 February 2004 from active military service and reverted to reserve status
