Constituted 3 November 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 3339th Quartermaster Service Detachment

Activated 28 January 1945 in New Guinea

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1945 as the 3339th Quartermaster Driver Detachment

Inactivated 10 October 1945 in New Guinea

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3339th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 5 November 1962 as the 339th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 15 February 1963 at Lexington, Nebraska

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Lexington, Nebraska

Activated 16 May 1983 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois

Ordered into active military service 20 September 1990 at Fort Sheridan, Illinois; released 28 May 1991 from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 September 1993 to Manhattan, Kansas

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Manhattan, Kansas; released from active military service 12 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status
