**353d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY**

Constituted 1 July 1936 in the Organized Reserves as Company D, 472d Quartermaster Regiment

Redesignated 1 April 1942 a Company D, 472d Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Ordered into active military service 15 February 1943 and organized at Camp Sutton, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1943 as the 372d Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 19 December 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3724th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 29 April 1947 as the 353d Transportation Truck Company

Activated 14 May 1947 at Sioux City, Iowa

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 22 May 1950 at Sioux City, Iowa

Redesignated 21 March 1952 as the 353d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Activated 15 April 1952 at Sioux City, Iowa

## **353d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY**

Reorganized and redesignated 7 April 1953 as the 353d Transportation Company

Location changed 18 May 1959 to Faribault, Minnesota; on 6 September 1968 to Buffalo, Minnesota

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Buffalo, Minnesota; released from active military service 9 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 28 July 2008 at Buffalo, Minnesota; released from active military service 31 August 2009 and reverted to reserve status
