### **358th TRANSPORTATION DETACHMENT (SCAN DEVILS)**

Constituted 3 November 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 3385th Quartermaster Service Detachment

Activated 12 December 1944 in the Philippines

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1945 as the 3385th Quartermaster Driver Detachment

Inactivated 10 October 1945 in Japan

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3385th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 7 July 1965 as the 358th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 21 July 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 17 February 1969 in Vietnam

Activated 22 November 1970 at Fort Eustis, Virginia


