Redesignated 22 June 1965 as the 383d Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 July 1965 at Fort Benning, Georgia

Inactivated 1 January 1967 at Qui Nhon, Vietnam

Activated 15 January 1968 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 25 June 1971 at Sattahip, Thailand

Activated 16 June 2000 at Fort Polk, Louisiana
