Activated 12 December 1944 in the Philippines

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1945 as the 3386th Quartermaster Driver Detachment

Inactivated 10 October 1945 in New Guinea

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3386th Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 7 July 1965 as the 386th Transportation Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 21 July 1965 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 30 June 1970 on Okinawa

Activated 17 September 2002 in Italy
