Redesignated 3 July 1947 as the 396th Transportation Truck Company

Allotted 13 December 1948 to the Regular Army

Redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 396th Transportation Company

Inactivated 25 March 1956 in Japan

Activated 1 June 1957 in Germany
