Constituted 15 October 1921 in the Organized Reserves as the 631st Motor Transport Company

Activated 18 October 1922 at Detroit, Michigan

Redesignated 1 July 1936 as Company K, 3d Battalion, 476th Quartermaster Regiment

Location changed 28 July 1937 to Lansing, Michigan; on 12 April 1939 to Detroit, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1942 as Company K, 3d Battalion, 476th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Ordered into active military service 31 March 1943 at Detroit, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 17 November 1943 as the 3810th Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 13 March 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3810th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 6 December 1946 as the 423d Transportation Corps Truck Company

Activated 23 December 1946 at Cheyenne, Wyoming

Redesignated 14 October 1947 as the 423d Transportation Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 April 1953 as the 423d Transportation Company

Inactivated 31 August 1959 at Cheyenne, Wyoming

Activated 16 October 1995 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Ordered into active military service 27 January 2003 at Fort Carson, Colorado; released from active military service 25 January 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 16 January-13 February 2006 at Fort Carson, Colorado; released from active military service 14 July-11 August 2007 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 April 2012 to Colorado Springs, Colorado
