430th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 25 April 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 430th Port Company, Transportation Corps

Activated 1 May 1944 at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 20 January 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 26 December 1947 as the 430th Transportation Port Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 13 January 1948 at Baltimore, Maryland

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 2 June 1953 as the 430th Transportation Company

Ordered into active military service 1 October 1961 at Baltimore, Maryland; released from active military service 7 August 1962 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 11 February 2003 at Baltimore, Maryland; released from active military service 10 February 2004 and reverted to reserve status

(Element ordered into active military service 25 October 2008 at Baltimore, Maryland; released from active military service 28 November 2009 and reverted to reserve status)
