432d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 25 April 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 432d Port Company, Transportation Corps

Activated 1 May 1944 at Indiantown Gap Military Reservation, Pennsylvania

Inactivated 6 April 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 13 February 1948 as the 432d Transportation Port Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 March 1948 at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 18 February 1955 as the 432d Transportation Company

Inactivated 1 January 1965 at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania

Activated 1 May 1975 at Fort Buchanan, Puerto Rico

Location changed 6 June 1977 to Bayamon, Puerto Rico; on 30 January 1994 to Ceiba, Puerto Rico

Ordered into active military service 11 February 2003 at Ceiba, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 9 July 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 19 January 2006 at Ceiba, Puerto Rico; released from active military service 17 July 2007 and reverted to reserve status


