Inactivated 2 April 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 441st Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 18 February 1949 as the 441st Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 24 March 1949 at Chicago, Illinois

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 10 April 1953 as the 441st Transportation Company

Location changed 21 September 1957 to Oak Park, Illinois; on 19 January 1964 to Forest Park, Illinois

Inactivated 31 January 1968 at Forest Park, Illinois

Activated 16 September 1991 at Pasadena, Texas

Location changed 1 June 1995 to Houston, Texas
