443d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 24 March 1923 in the Regular Army as Motor Transport Company 29, 8th Division Train

Redesignated 23 May 1925 as the 29th Motor Transport Company, an element of the 8th Division

Activated 14 December 1926 at Washington, D.C.

Relieved 15 August 1927 from assignment to the 8th Division and assigned to the 4th Division

Relieved 18 August 1933 from assignment to the 4th Division and assigned to the 8th Division

Redesignated 1 May 1936 as Company C, 1st Battalion, 8th Quartermaster Regiment

Redesignated 29 September 1939 as Company F, 2d Battalion, 23d Quartermaster Regiment, and relieved from assignment to the 8th Division

Inactivated 30 April 1941 at Washington, D.C.

Redesignated 16 June 1942 as Company F, 2d Battalion, 23d Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 15 August 1942 at Camp Barkeley, Texas

443d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 15 December 1943 as the 3346th Quartermaster Truck Company

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3346th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Inactivated 30 September 1946 in Korea

Redesignated 6 March 1947 as the 6th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 9 December 1947 as the 443d Transportation Truck Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 10 January 1948 at Ogden, Utah

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 15 April 1953 as the 443d Transportation Company

Inactivated 1 July 1959 at Ogden, Utah

Activated 15 February 1963 at Ogden, Utah

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Ogden, Utah

Activated 16 October 1995 at Great Bend, Kansas

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Great Bend, Kansas; released from active military service 3 June 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 September 2006 to Omaha, Nebraska

Ordered into active military service 15 February 2009 at Omaha, Nebraska
