454th TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Constituted 1 May 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 454th Amphibian Truck Company, Transportation Corps, and activated at Charleston, South Carolina

Inactivated 30 January 1946 in the Ryukyu Islands

Allotted 26 February 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 11 March 1947 at Dayton, Ohio

Redesignated 13 October 1947 as the 454th Transportation Amphibious Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 3 April 1950 to St. Marys, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 28 October 1953 as the 454th Transportation Company

Inactivated 4 April 1963 at St. Marys, Ohio

Activated 16 September 1997 at Blacklick, Ohio

Location changed 1 June 1999 to Columbus, Ohio

Ordered into active military service 7 December 2003 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 15 April 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 10 July 2006 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 5 January 2008 and reverted to reserve status
