Constituted 17 June 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 465th Amphibian Truck Company and activated at Camp Edwards, Massachusetts

Inactivated 8 December 1945 in Japan

Activated 26 June 1947 at Scranton, Pennsylvania and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Redesignated 13 October 1947 as the 465th Transportation Amphibious Truck Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 28 October 1953 as the 465th Transportation Company

Inactivated 28 March 1963 at Scranton, Pennsylvania

Activated 16 October 1995 at Bristol, Pennsylvania
