Reconstituted 31 July 1947 in the Organized Reserves as the 481st Transportation Port Company

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 30 November 1950 at Oakland, California

Redesignated 24 November 1967 as the 481st Transportation Company


