Redesignated 20 July 1947 as the 515th Transportation Truck Company

Allotted 1 February 1953 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 515th Transportation Company

Inactivated 20 March 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 October 1982 in Germany
