Withdrawn 20 July 1995 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 1 September 1997 at Sherman Oaks, California

Location changed 1 August 2002 to Camp Pendleton, California

Ordered into active military service 22 September 2004 at Camp Pendleton, California;
released from active military service 20 March 2006 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2007 at Camp Pendleton, California

Activated 16 September 2010 at McAllen, Texas
