Redesignated 28 November 1951 as the 523d Transportation Truck Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 7 January 1952 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Reorganized and redesignated 11 June 1953 as the 523d Transportation Company

Inactivated 27 March 1956 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Activated 15 February 1958 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts

Inactivated 25 March 1962 at Fort Carson, Colorado

Activated 18 May 1966 at Fort Campbell, Kentucky
