Constituted 23 March 1966 in the Regular Army as the 528th Transportation Detachment

Activated 1 June 1966 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 15 August 1972 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 3 October 1989 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 16 September 1992 at Gainesville, Florida

Ordered into active military service 16 October 1997 at Gainesville, Florida; released from active military service 12 July 1998 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 10 November 1999 to Perrine, Florida

Ordered into active military service 25 November 2002 at Perrine, Florida; 528th Transportation Detachment (less Detachment 1) released from active military service 6 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status (Detachment 1 released from active military service 22 November 2004 and reverted to reserve status)
