Activated 28 December 1943 at New Orleans, Louisiana

Reorganized and redesignated 21 December 1945 as the 785th Transportation Corps Base Depot Company

Inactivated 29 May 1946 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Redesignated 26 August 1950 as the 554th Transportation Warehouse Detachment

Activated 14 September 1950 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 15 August 1952 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Redesignated 29 August 1956 as the 554th Transportation Detachment, allotted to the Army Reserve, and activated at Junction City, Kansas

Inactivated 30 September 1959 at Junction City, Kansas

Activated 15 July 1964 at Freeport, Illinois

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Freeport, Illinois

Activated 16 March 1986 at Charleston, South Carolina

Activated 16 September 2009 at Sinton, Texas


