Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 31 July 1942 as Company B, 399th Port Battalion, Transportation Corps

Reorganized and redesignated 25 January 1944 as the 567th Port Company

Inactivated 17 September 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 12 January 1956 as the 567th Transportation Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 February 1956 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 15 November 1957 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Activated 24 January 1966 at Fort Eustis, Virginia


