Inactivated 24 September 1945 in the Philippines

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3352d Transportation Corps Driver Detachment

Redesignated 26 December 1950 as the 573d Transportation Driver Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 25 August 1951 in Korea

Inactivated 1 November 1951 in Korea

Redesignated 23 March 1955 as the 573d Transportation Detachment

Activated 10 April 1955 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma

Inactivated 15 July 1955 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma

Activated 20 June 1956 at Fort Riley, Kansas

Inactivated 25 November 1968 in Vietnam


