Activated 1 March 1944 at Camp Millard, Ohio

Redesignated 21 April 1945 as the 117th Transportation Corps Hospital Train Maintenance Detachment

Inactivated 12 November 1945 in France

Redesignated 12 March 1951 as the 584th Transportation Hospital Train Maintenance Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Redesignated 11 June 1954 as the 584th Transportation Detachment

Activated 15 July 1954 at Fort Eustis, Virginia

Inactivated 1 June 1956 at Charleston, South Carolina

Activated 25 September 1960 in Korea

Inactivated 15 December 1972 in Korea

Activated 1 July 1984 in England

Inactivated 1 December 1993 in England

Activated 16 October 1999 in Korea


