Constituted 10 November 1942 in the Army of the United States as Company I, 467th Quartermaster Truck Regiment

Activated 10 December 1942 at Fort Custer, Michigan

Reorganized and redesignated 11 December 1943 as the 3629th Quartermaster Truck Company

Inactivated 15 October 1945 at Camp Miles Standish, Massachusetts

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as the 3629th Transportation Corps Truck Company

Redesignated 17 March 1948 as the 623d Transportation Truck Company and concurrently allotted to the Organized Reserves

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Activated 2 April 1948 at Utica, New York

Inactivated 31 July 1950 at Utica, New York

Redesignated 1 April 1952 as the 623d Transportation Heavy Truck Company

Activated 1 May 1952 at Watertown, New York

623d TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1953 as the 623d Transportation Company and location changed to Brooklyn, New York

Location changed 31 January 1968 to Fort Totten, New York

Ordered into active military service 24 March 1970 at Fort Hamilton, New York; released from active military service 26 March 1970 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 11 October 1990 at Fort Totten, New York; released from active military service 30 April 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 24 January 2003 at Fort Totten, New York; released from active military service 1 August 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 15 September 2006 at Fort Totten, New York

Activated 16 September 2011 at West Palm Beach, Florida
