Withdrawn 20 September 1994 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 1 September 1996 at Tacoma, Washington

Ordered into active military service 10 February 2003 at Tacoma, Washington; released from active military service 3 July 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 8 October 2009 at Tacoma, Washington; released from active military service 11 November 2010 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 December 2015 to Fort Lewis, Washington

Ordered into active military service 30 May 2019 at Fort Lewis, Washington; released from active military service 28 May 2020 and reverted to reserve status
